Rimsky Korsakov, *Scheherazade*, Last mvt.: Letter U (play for 16 measures) and seventeen measures after Letter V (play for 12 measures)

Ravel, *Piano Concerto*: Mvt. I, solo fourteen measures before 3 to the downbeat at 3

Rossini, *La Scala (The Silken Ladder)*: from 13, play for 16 measures (soli with oboe)

Ippolitov-Ivanov, *Caucasian Sketches*, No. 4 Cortège of the Sardar: from eight measures before Rehearsal A to the downbeat of Rehearsal B, and from Rehearsal E to six measures after Rehearsal G.
